

Fall/Winter Decoration Rules

Fall clean-up begins on **October 13th** (weather permitting). If you want to retain your decoration, you **MUST** pick it up before this date. Please do not place **any** decorations until November 15th.

Grave vases cannot be used during the winter because any water within will freeze and crack the vase or they can be hit during snow removal operations.

Wreaths and other decorations **must** be tall enough to be seen above the snow. **Evergreen grave blankets and sprays are not allowed and will be removed.** No decorations will be allowed to lie flat on a grave.

All winter-seasonal holiday decorations for graves, crypts and niches will be removed in mid January, weather permitting. If you would like to retain your decorations, you should remove them before then. **WE WILL NO LONGER SAVE OR STORE THESE DECORATIONS!**

Mausoleums will be cleared of faded, out-of-season, and unsightly decorations during the fall clean-up. Flowers may be placed year-round **only** in crypt or niche vases. Fall decorations are permitted on crypts and niches only. Decorations are prohibited on the ground, sidewalk, on top of any mausoleum or cremation niche structure, inserted into any cracks between crypt or niche doors, into cracks between sidewalks and buildings, or any that hang or drape over an adjoining crypt or niche.

Only cemetery-approved vases or accessories will be affixed to the door or a crypt or niche by cemetery staff only. **Use of adhesives, tape, or wire to attach anything to a crypt or niche is strictly prohibited.** Crypt and niche owners are responsible and will be billed for the cost of repair or replacement of doors if a carelessly placed decoration or tape causes any damage.
