TAX PAYMENT DUE DATES

REAL ESTATE TAXES:

Option 1: Due in full by January 31, 2015

Option 2: *Installment Plan (see below)

Payment 1 → Due by January 31, 2015

Payment 2 → Due by March 31, 2015

Payment 3 → Due by May 31, 2015

PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES:

Due in full by January 31, 2015

***INSTALLMENT PLAN:** If any payment is not received on time, the entire unpaid balance becomes delinquent and interest and penalty will be charged. The charge will be 1.5% per month on the unpaid balance, retroactive to February 1st.




DOG & CAT LICENSES SOLD IN CLERK/TREASURER'S OFFICE
