

Madison Street Reconstruction

Construction Start Update

Many of you have likely heard the news that Madison Street will be reconstructed soon. Indeed this is true. Madison Street will be reconstructed from Prairie Song Drive to the western edge of the City limits. When the project is completed, the new street will look the same as Madison Street exists today to east of Prairie Song Drive with improved driver visibility, wider drive lanes, curb & gutter, and sidewalks on both sides of the street, Watermain and storm sewer will also be constructed.

Approximately ½ mile of Madison Street will be reconstructed. We are hopeful that this work will begin this week. Soon you will see a road closure of Madison Street to the west of Prairie Song Drive; however, the intersection of Madison Street and Prairie Song Drive will remain open allowing for traffic to flow freely to the east to the new bypass or to the north to Summit Ave (USH 18). The road closure of Madison Street is expected to last until the middle of November.
