

# Using our new fareboxes



**Our new fareboxes make it easy to pay your fare.**

You can pay with cash, or save money on every ride with convenient 10-Ride Cards, Day Passes or 31-Day Passes.

## Using a Card

### 10-Ride Card, Value Card

Insert the card in slot **1**. It will pull the card in and eject it after deducting the ride or the fare amount.

## Using a Pass

### 31-Day Pass, Day Pass

The first time you use your pass, activate it by inserting it in slot **1**. It will pull the card in and eject it after activating.

The next time you ride, simply swipe the card through slot **2**.

## Paying with Cash

Simply insert bills and/or coins in the appropriate slots. Please pay exact fare.

If you overpay, a Fare Value Card will be issued from slot **1** in the amount of overpayment. This card can be used as payment on future trips by inserting in slot **1**, but has no cash value and is not refundable.



## Transfers

When paying your fare in cash, ask the driver for a transfer if you plan to use another bus to complete your trip. A transfer card will be issued from slot **1**. On your next bus, simply swipe the transfer through slot **2**.

A transfer is valid for 90 minutes from your first trip. A transfer is automatically encoded on a 10-Ride Card or Value Card.
